

Marie Curie (1867-1934)

received a Nobel Prize in 1903 for work on radioactivity. In 1911, she received a second one for Chemistry. Curie is the only woman to receive two Nobel Prizes. The prize was first given in 1901 with money left by Alfred Nobel who invented dynamite. Prizes are awarded each year in: Physics, Chemistry, Medicine, Literature, and World Peace.
